



Additional Paper B. Interventions Funding Update

Purpose: To provide a financial reconciliation about Suffolk Economic Strategy Interventions (May 2024-present) and the overall funding position for the Business Board.

1. Executive Summary

This report provides a financial overview of Suffolk Business Board decisions related to Economic Strategy interventions from May 2024 to the present. It includes approved budgets relating to the New Anglia LEP legacy fund, retained rates funding generated from Suffolk Enterprise Zones and some legacy LEP loans which have been repaid.

In total since May 2024 £4.655m has been allocated from these funding pots to deliver the Suffolk Economy Strategy. This leaves £14.7m available for future investments.

2. Investments

Previously approved:

- **Integrated Water Action Plan (I-WAP): £50k;** £150k total cost shared with NCC & Reclaim the Rain.
- **New Anglia Capital: £300k;** Allocated as part of LEP integration and approved via SCC Cabinet paper.

First Wave Interventions (Approved January 2025)

The first wave of interventions marked the formal start of delivery. Below are the interventions and their associated financial details:

- **Suffolk Economy Grants:** £1m grant fund; expected £2.37m private match; grants range £2.5k–£100k depending on business size.
- **Local Area Energy Plan (LAEP):** £100k Suffolk contribution; £200k total project cost shared with Norfolk.
- **Advanced Manufacturing & Engineering (AME) Centre:** £2m capital grant; £166k/year for 15 years; towards estimated £15m construction cost.
- **Knowledge Exchange Vouchers:** £30k funding pot in a business matched scheme delivering vouchers at £3,200 each enabling student placements access to research and innovation from UOS.

Subsequent Approvals (March 2025 – December 2025)

Following the first wave, the Board approved additional interventions and supporting activities:

- **Suffolk Showcase (Events, Marketing & Toolkit):** £50k initial approval; later increased to £75k.
- **Innovation Martlesham Regional Cluster:** £270k over a 3-year period.

- **AI Awards; £20k**
- **Cluster Analysis & Feasibility Study: £104k** fixed budget for evidence base and roadmap
- **Cluster Development Plan & Mission Catalyst: £80k** mobilisation fund; future funding via Innovation Challenge Fund (TBD during 2026).
- **Enhanced Apprenticeships Suffolk: £111k** to expand existing service with a stronger offer for employers during 26/27.
- **Energy Readiness Project: £130k** 1 year funding 26/27 (with a commitment to consider 2 further years for a total investment of £350k).
- **Thrive Young People Phase 3: £385k** to continue youth employment support during 26/27.

3. Remaining Investment Fund balance

£14.7m remains in this fund to be invested in Economic Strategy delivery activities and will continue to be annually topped up by un-utilised Enterprise Zone income (until such a time as Enterprise Zone income is transferred to the future Mayor).
